## 2026 WYOMING WOMEN'S STATE BOWLING TOURNAMENT

1520 Coffeen Ave., Sheridan, Wyoming 82801

- 1- Entries close and must be postmarked no later than Monday, April 1st, 2026. Rule 310A. Late entries are at the discretion of the tournament manager.
- 2- The Tournament is open to all Wyoming State USBC members and/or Wyoming residents. All entrants must have a Wyoming USBC card.
- 3- AVERAGE: Bowlers will use their highest sanctioned average with 21 or more games from either 24-25 Season book average (summer or winter) or mid-season as of 12/31/2025. All other bowlers will bowl scratch ---  
No Ten Pin Rule -----
- 4- **Handicap will be 90% of the difference from 230. With No Maximum handicap.**
- 5- It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average for this tournament, whether it was originally submitted by the bowler, team captain, or others. Failure to use the correct average shall result in disqualification.
- 6- Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average, if it is higher than the actual average.
- 7- Correction in averages must be made by the completion of the effective bowlers first game of the tournament. USBC rules 319 D & E will apply. Rule 319A1. (b) Does not apply
- 8- Cash prizes will be paid for scratch and handicap events. 30% of the prize fund will be used for scratch prizes, and 70% of the prize fund will be used for handicap prizes. Each entrant may win cash in either (not both) handicap or scratch events based on the highest payout. At the ratio of 1/10 in all events except all events. All events will be paid out in the ratio of 1/15.
- 9- Trophies will be awarded to both scratch and handicap winners. The Wyoming State USBC will reserve one entry for the next **upcoming** USBC Queen's Tournament for the Scratch All Events Winner, or runner up. Entry will be paid up to \$500 and \$250 towards expenses with receipts.
- 10- Entrants may bowl each event two (2) times. 2 Teams, 2 Doubles and 2 Singles, but may only cash once with the same partner and team changing at least two (2) bowlers. First score in team, doubles & singles event counts toward "All Events" total.

**SENIOR QUALIFYING**

- 1- Entry is open to USBC members who are 50 years of age or older **on or before entry deadline of 4/1/26. (rule #1)**
- 2- Entry fee is \$25.00 (prize fund \$13.00 & Expenses \$12.00)
- 3- Divisions will consist of: Age 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74 and 75 and older.
- 4- All prize money will be returned 100% in each division at least 1 for 10. First place winner in each age division will have entry fee paid to the **upcoming** National Senior Tournament.

- 11- To enter Singles or Doubles, you must bowl both events consecutively and will be bowled on same lanes. This is considered one squad. **Doubles first, Singles second.** Singles and Doubles must enter on the same entry form. Due to Physical Impairment, if a bowler can't bowl more than 3 games at a time, please contact the Tournament Director to make arrangements.

- 12- All bowlers are requested to check in **30 minutes prior to squad time. Bring USBC card to check in if unable to verify with Bowl.com**

- 13- Substitutions for absent bowlers and any changes will be allowed up to 30 minutes prior to squad start time. Do not send in names of replacement bowlers by mail. Replacements will be registered at check-in. But may call Tournament Director with change. Once you start a series no sub will be allowed in any event.

- 14- No Telephone Reservations will be accepted.

- 15- Recap sheets will be the official score sheet. Errors must be brought to the attention of the tournament official within 30 minutes after the completion of the event, otherwise all scores will be official. Rule 327c "Loss of Scores" applies.

- 16- Tournament officials may remove a bowler from the lanes due to misconduct or actions that are detrimental to good bowling etiquette. Appropriate non-offensive attire in accordance with USBC's Rules

- 17- Team captains will be sent a confirmation acknowledging receipt of their entry by marking below: Email-- Web -- Mail

- 18- USBC Rules will apply to anything not covered by these rules. accordance with USBC's Rules

- 19- **Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament management. Tournament management's decision will be final. For questions on appropriate attire, contact the Tournament Office . Entrants are expected to wear suitable attire. Use Good Judgment when selecting the appropriate attire.**

**Tournament Director and the decision of the Tournament Director is final.**

**Squad changes if needed will be decided by the Tournament Director.**

- 5- Tournament will consist of 9 game total. (team, singles, doubles) First score in each event will count.

- 6- Entering average based on above rules.

- 7- Handicap based on above rule #4.

- 8- USBC Rules will apply to anything not covered by these rules.
